Required: Please read one of the following.

A Single Shard by Linda Sue Park

OR

The Black Arrow by Robert Louis Stevenson

Choose two books from the following list: *Do not choose books that you have already read!*

1. *The Tempest* by William Shakespeare *must be full, original text
2. *Sword Song* by Rosemary Sutcliff
3. *Sir Gawain and the Green Knight (A New Verse Translation)* by Simon Armitage
4. *Enter Three Witches* by Caroline Cooney
5. *The Door in the Wall* by Marguerite De Angeli
6. *Queen Eleanor: Independent Spirit of the Medieval World* by Polly Schoyer Brooks

Please note: While all books listed above are significant, the order of importance is connected to the course reading chronologically.

Optional Viewing: Students will learn Joseph Campbell's motifs and archetypes of the mythic hero when we study Roger Lancelyn Green's *King Arthur* this year. While not required, viewing any of the Star Wars saga episodes I - VII will help your student make meaningful connections and valuable applications as we study mythic hero archetypes.
